

Luiss and Leonardo S.p.a. International Training Program – Call for Applications a.y. 2020/2021

Subject matter of the call for applications

Luiss Guido Carli announces a competition for the admission of two students to the Leonardo ITP - International Training Program, an advanced training program organized and funded jointly by Luiss Guido Carli and Leonardo. The program blends academic education with practical business experience within the framework of the master's degree program in Management, whose constituent courses are taught entirely in English. This call for applications is addressed to particularly brilliant students who hold or will hold by July 2020 a bachelor's degree from a non-Italian university and who come from Brazil and Argentina.

Each of the admitted students will be awarded a scholarship covering tuition fees (except for some taxes payable by law) and all costs for accommodation and meals for their stay in Rome for the entire normal duration of the program (2 academic years). Moreover, during the program the students will have the opportunity to undertake an internship and upon completion of the program Leonardo will offer a job to the scholarship recipients in the countries that the program focuses on.

Selection process

The selection process will be split into the following rounds:

1. Date from which applications can be submitted	2. Deadline for submission of applications	3. Communication of outcome

To participate in the selection process it is necessary to fill out a specific "[APPLICATION FORM](#)" online by the relevant deadlines indicated in Column 1 – Deadline for Submission of Application.



Documents or information required to complete the online application process (pdf or image file format):

- certificate showing the studies completed to date (academic transcript updated to the time of the application) and associated grades (Grade Point Average);
- details of the lecturer chosen to furnish a letter of reference (including e-mail address; upon submission of the application the lecturer will receive a request to provide a letter of reference for the candidate);
- other optional certification (for example, GMAT www.gmac.com, GRE www.ets.org);
- a short motivation letter (maximum 2,400 characters spaces included).

Multiple applications from the same candidate will not be considered.

Admission Process

Eligibility

Only applications accompanied by documentation that is complete and compliant with the applicable regulations governing qualifications granting access to university studies will be considered (for more information candidates are advised to read [The Rules of University Enrollment by Foreign Students](#)).

Selection

The eligible candidacies will be examined by a special Admissions Commission, which – at its absolute discretion – will draw up a ranking taking into account:

- the compatibility of the bachelor's degree held with the master's degree program applied for;
- the passing of at least six core exams during the bachelor's degree program pertinent to the chosen master's degree program;
- academic record;
- reasons for applying for the degree program;
- the age of the candidate;
- professional experience;
- GMAT/GRE scores (if any).

During this stage candidates could well be contacted for an oral interview by Skype with the Admissions Commission.

Admission

All candidacies will be assessed at the same time as receipt and candidates will be informed (by e-mail sent to the account specified during the application process) of the final outcome of their application – positive or negative as the case may be – for admission to their chosen degree program.

Candidates will be conditionally admitted at first, and thereafter fully admitted solely upon receipt of the original documentation, the statement of equivalent value and, for non-EU citizens, certification regarding the personal identity of the student and a visa. Candidates who are not admitted to the ITP Program but meet all the requirements for international selection may be contacted to explore opportunities for potential admission to other Luiss Guido Carli programs.

Acceptance of Admission

Acceptance of the offer of admission must be communicated by and no later than seven days after receipt of the admission e-mail, writing directly to ammissione@luiss.it. Acceptance implies compulsory attendance at courses commencing from 14 September 2020 since the arrival of students after that date is not envisioned.

Please note that the offer of admission will refer exclusively to the 2020/2021 academic year and will not be considered as valid for admission in subsequent years.

Enrollment

Successful candidates will be asked to enroll by filling out the required documentation and paying the relevant fees by the deadlines communicated by the Admissions Office. The documentation will have to be sent to:

Please note that candidates must have been awarded their bachelor's degree by and no later than 16 November 2020.

It should be borne in mind that pursuant to Ministry of Education, Universities and Research (MIUR) regulations, qualifications awarded abroad grant access to an Italian university only if they:

- have been awarded by official schools in that foreign country's education system;
- entitle the student to enroll in universities of the foreign country that awarded them;
- have been awarded on completion of a minimum of 12 years of overall schooling (primary and secondary education) and a bachelor's degree program lasting at least 3 years.

Candidates can contact [CIMEA](#) for an advance assessment of their foreign qualifications.

For any information regarding one's qualifications and how to obtain a visa/study permit, the onus is on candidates to timely read "[The Rules of University Enrollment by Foreign Students](#)" and to contact the local Italian diplomatic authorities in the foreign country whose school system awards the qualification, also in order to comply with the administrative procedures for the issuance of the required

Confirmation of the scholarship

The scholarship will be confirmed for the second year on condition that by 31 July 2021 the grantee has earned at least 70% of the education credits required under the study plan for graduation and has a weighted grade average of not less than 27/30.



Revocation of the scholarship

The scholarship will be revoked if the grantee:

- fails to complete the enrollment process for the 2020/2021 academic year at Luiss Guido Carli in the manner and by the deadline specified in this Call for Applications;
- discontinues his or her studies;
- transfers to another degree program or university.
